Demo Environment

Demo Environment connects companies, organizations and authorities to share top knowledge and technology to improve living conditions and fight climate change. It connects companies who have innovative solutions to global environmental challenges with expertise on how these solutions can be tailored to the local context in 11 different partner countries.

The Demo Environment programs have since 2007 supported the exchange of knowledge and business opportunities to make a difference in the fight against poverty and environmental challenges.

The program is a challenge fund financed by the Swedish Agency for International Development (Sida) and managed by the Swedish Agency for Economic and Regional Growth (Tillväxtverket).

A shortcut to world leading green technology

Demo Environment offers local actors an opportunity to introduce innovative technology to their market at reduced risk. It finances demonstration projects that provide solutions to local environmental challenges. The best applications are awarded between 500,000 and 1,800,000 SEK. Up to 50 per cent of invoiced amounts for equipment and up to 80 per cent of invoiced amounts for services can be funded by Tillväxtverket. The other 50 and 20 per cent respectively need to be co-financed by the applicant.

A unique business opportunity

Demo Environment opens up new markets for green technology and facilitates business partnerships with local expertise. It finances planning grants that enables actors to develop their technology and knowledge in a new environment. A maximum of 350,000 SEK can be awarded for planning grants.

How it works

Demo Environment will run 2015-2018. It awards funds on a competitive basis and calls for application will be published on www.tillvaxtverket.se/demoenvironment. Applicants in a partnership can apply for a planning grant, support for a demonstration project or both subsequently.
